General information for Applicants:

1. The Vikings Cycling Club (**VCC**) may, in its absolute discretion, decide to reimburse part or all of the costs of VCC members undertaking Cycling ACT's Road and Track Skills Cycle Course (**Course**) (which may include costs associated with obtaining the requisite first aid certificate).
2. It is a pre-requisite for any reimbursement that the Applicant completes the Course.
3. If the VCC elects to reimburse the Applicant for part or all of the Applicant's costs, the VCC expects that the successful Applicant would:
 - a. assist the VCC run coached sessions (including club-based training, track sessions and novice programs) on an as requested basis so as to assist the VCC meets Cycling Australia's coach / athlete ratios;
 - b. not charge the VCC (or any member of the VCC) for undertaking coaching activities on behalf of the VCC unless otherwise agreed by the VCC;
 - c. remain a member of the VCC for at least one year following the date of the reimbursement; and
 - d. have and maintain a Working With Vulnerable People Registration for the duration of the time the Applicant is involved with coaching activities.
